120 SPECIAL PROJECTS

Last year, 120 projects were completed, including five remodeled bathrooms, five updated kitchens, 19 new floors, and 37 large exterior projects such as new roof systems, decks, ramps, poured concrete, siding, and tree removals.

PCH is always implementing projects to ensure comfort with new HVAC systems, new appliances, fresh paint and more. We also prioritize accessibility with even-surface floors, walk-in/roll-in showers, and entrance ramps.

NEARLY 1,900 WORK ORDERS

During 2024, the hard-working team of five maintenance technicians were on-call 24 hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days.

Throughout 85 homes, the amazing PCH maintenance team fulfilled 1,879 work orders— a combination of preventive maintenance, corrective requests, and emergency repairs.

The AHAP tax credit is a one-time credit that may be allocated to an **eligible** donor for up to 55% of the total value of an **eligible** donation given between July 12, 2024, and April 30, 2025.

The credit may be applied against liability for Missouri corporate income tax, individual income tax, and other Missouri tax from business activities (including individuals with rental income).
