Each home serves adults with intellectual/developmental disabilities (I/DD) as they age and is maintained by an expert team, for life.

While known and beloved to our families and donors for almost 50 years, we've learned that **today**, our mission, offering and the population we serve are often misunderstood by our name alone. Now with 88 homes throughout St. Louis, more than 300 residents and more than 1,000 visitors to the Wolff Community Center – we are striving to inspire new generations of partners and advocates.

We wanted you to know that as of January 1, 2021, our brand name is Promise Community Homes. This change is made to best communicate our unique offering of safe, affordable, accessible homes within the community.
